Additional information submitted in response to a request from EFSA during the assessment of a proposed extension of use of the food additive Quillaia extract (E 999) was presented and discussed. The WG agreed to continue with the assessment. Subject to these revisions a draft document will be scheduled for discussion in a forthcoming WG meeting.
