## Proposal for Amendment to Legal Inspection of Children's Raincoat

By the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection (BSMI), Ministry of Economic Affairs

## **Background:**

The Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection is proposing to adopt the most recent version of standard, CNS 15503 "General requirements for safety of children's products," published on 18 October 2018, as the inspection standard for children's raincoat. In this revised version, among all the changes, DMP and DEP are deleted from the scope of restricted phthalates, which reduces the number of restricted phthalates from 8 to 6 (DEHP, DBP, BBP, DINP, DIDP, and DNOP) and the sum of the total mixture of them cannot be over 0.1% (wt/wt).
