## **ANNEX I**

In Annex I to Implementing Regulation (EU) No 2015/1295, the column ‘Specific provisions’ is replaced by the following:

‘Only uses in permanent greenhouses may be authorised.

For the implementation of the uniform principles as referred to in Article 29(6) of Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009, the conclusions of the review report on sulfoxaflor, and in particular Appendices I and II thereof, as finalised in the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed on 29 May 2015 and updated on 2 December 2021, shall be taken into account.

In this overall assessment, Member States shall pay particular attention to the risk to bees and bumble bees released for pollination, when products containing the substance are applied in greenhouses.

Conditions of use shall include risk mitigation measures, where appropriate.’

## **ANNEX II**

The column ‘Specific provisions’ of row 88, sulfoxaflor, in Part B of the Annex to Implementing Regulation (EU) No 540/2011 is replaced by the following:

‘Only uses in permanent greenhouses may be authorised.

For the implementation of the uniform principles as referred to in Article 29(6) of Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009, the conclusions of the review report on sulfoxaflor, and in particular Appendices I and II thereof, as finalised in the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed on 29 May 2015 and updated on 2 December 2021, shall be taken into account.

In this overall assessment, Member States shall pay particular attention to the risk to bees and bumble bees released for pollination, when products containing the substance are applied in greenhouses.

Conditions of use shall include risk mitigation measures, where appropriate.’
